CASE FILE:



SUBJECT:

Kackle the Clown, recently escaped from prison, former founder of Swivel Inc.

OBJECTIVE:

In today's episode, Ryan goes undercover as "Giggles the Clown" and learns that God can give you joy even when things aren't going so well.



DISCUSSION GUIDE:

- 1. In todays story, Ryan was having a really bad day. What was he most upset about? (He missed his dad) Have you ever had a really bad day or something sad happen to you? What happened?
- 2. When Ryan pretended to be happy, did it make him feel better? What are some things people do to try to make themselves happy? (eat candy, buy things, etc) Do these things last?
- **3.** Happiness is just a feeling that comes and goes. But joy can be with us no matter what. How do we get joy? (Joy comes only from God. The bible says that joy is like a fruit that grows in our hearts the more we get to know Jesus. Galatians 5:22)


- 4. What are some ways you can grow your relationship with Jesus? (pray, read bible, praise him, etc)
- 5. In today's bible story, do you think Paul and Silas really felt like singing after they were beaten and chained? Then why did they do it? (They knew God was with them and was bigger than their problems.)
