DISCUSSION GUIDE:


- 1. Have you ever been on a team? If so, what kind? (ex: sports, club, etc.) Are there any sports that would be hard to play alone?
- 2. What makes somebody a bad team player? Why do you think Ryan wanted to do things all by himself? (He was proud)
- 3. Did you know that God makes each and every person special? We are all good at different things! That's why we need each other. What's something you are good at doing?
- 4. Did you know that God wants your family to work together like a team? What are things you can do to help your family?

- 5. How do you think you could use that skill to serve God or help others?
- 6. In today's story, how did Moses' friends help him? (They held up his arms when he was tired.)
- 7. Was there a time when you helped somebody in need? Was there a time when you needed help?
- 8. All of God's children are like secret agents on a special mission- to share God's love with the whole world! But we are also still in training. Every time you learn a new skill, ask God to show you how you can use it to accomplish His mission!
